A Self-Guided Tour Featuring the Trees of Governors Island

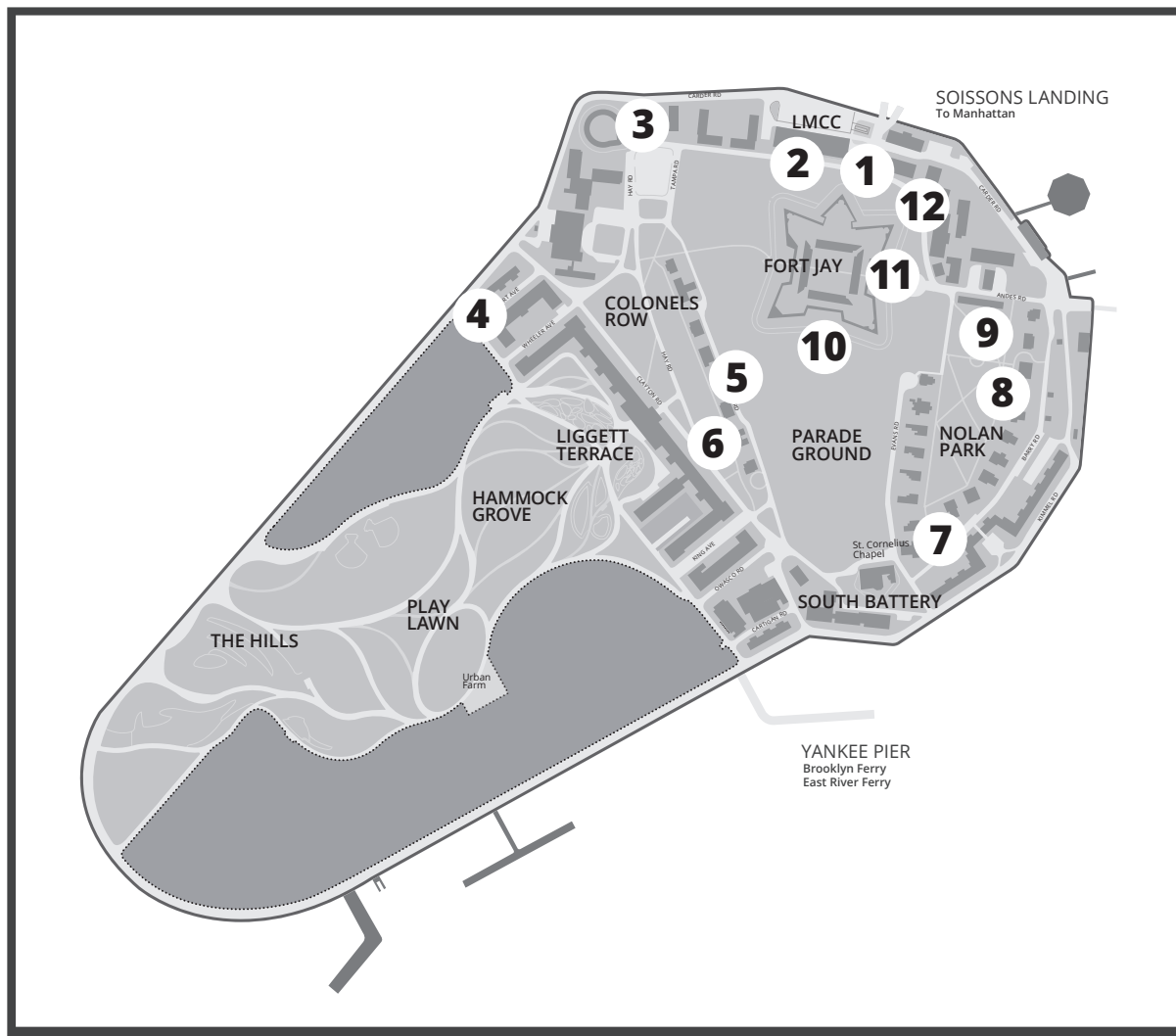
Find the Trees
