*A Self-Guided Tour Featuring the Trees of Governors Island*

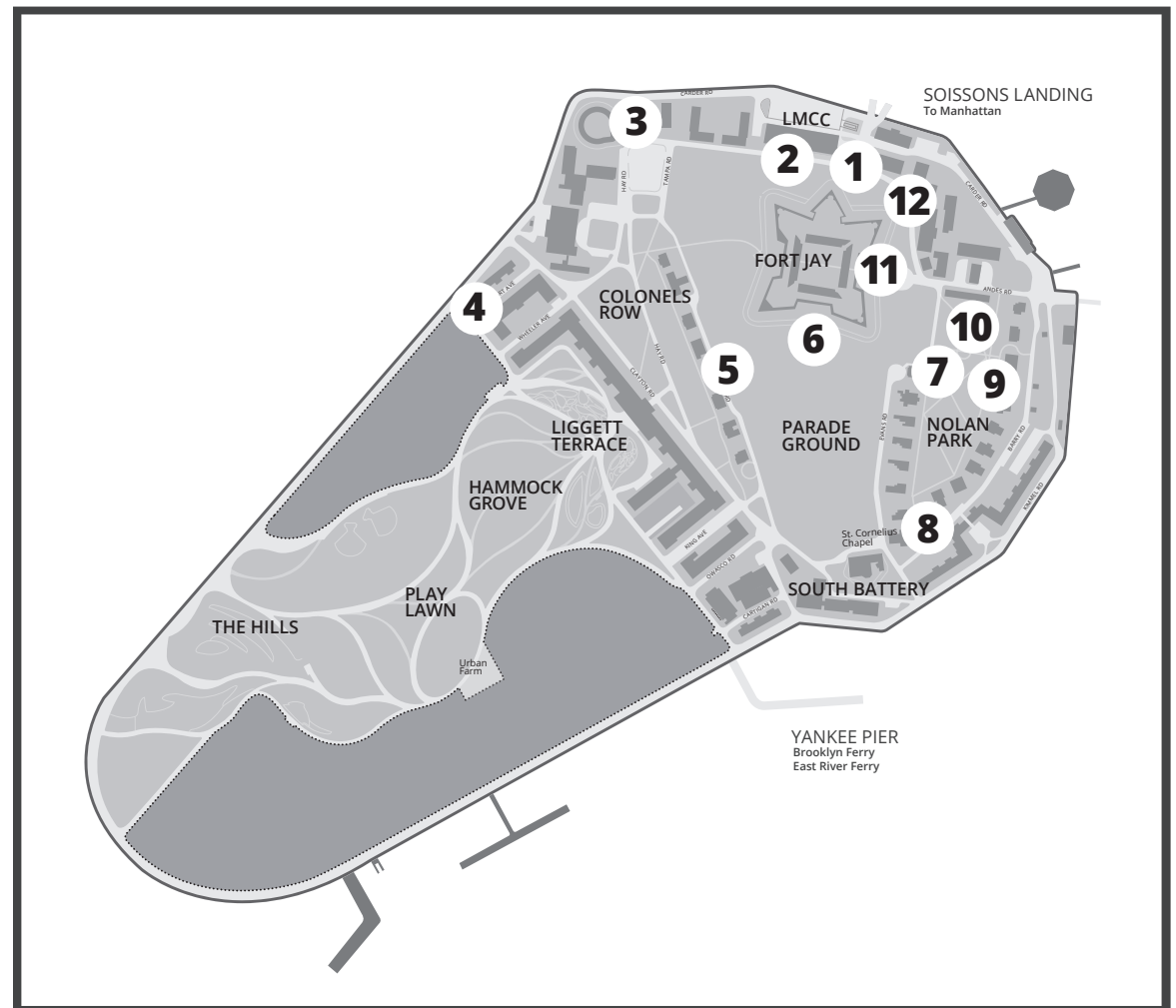
## Find the Trees
